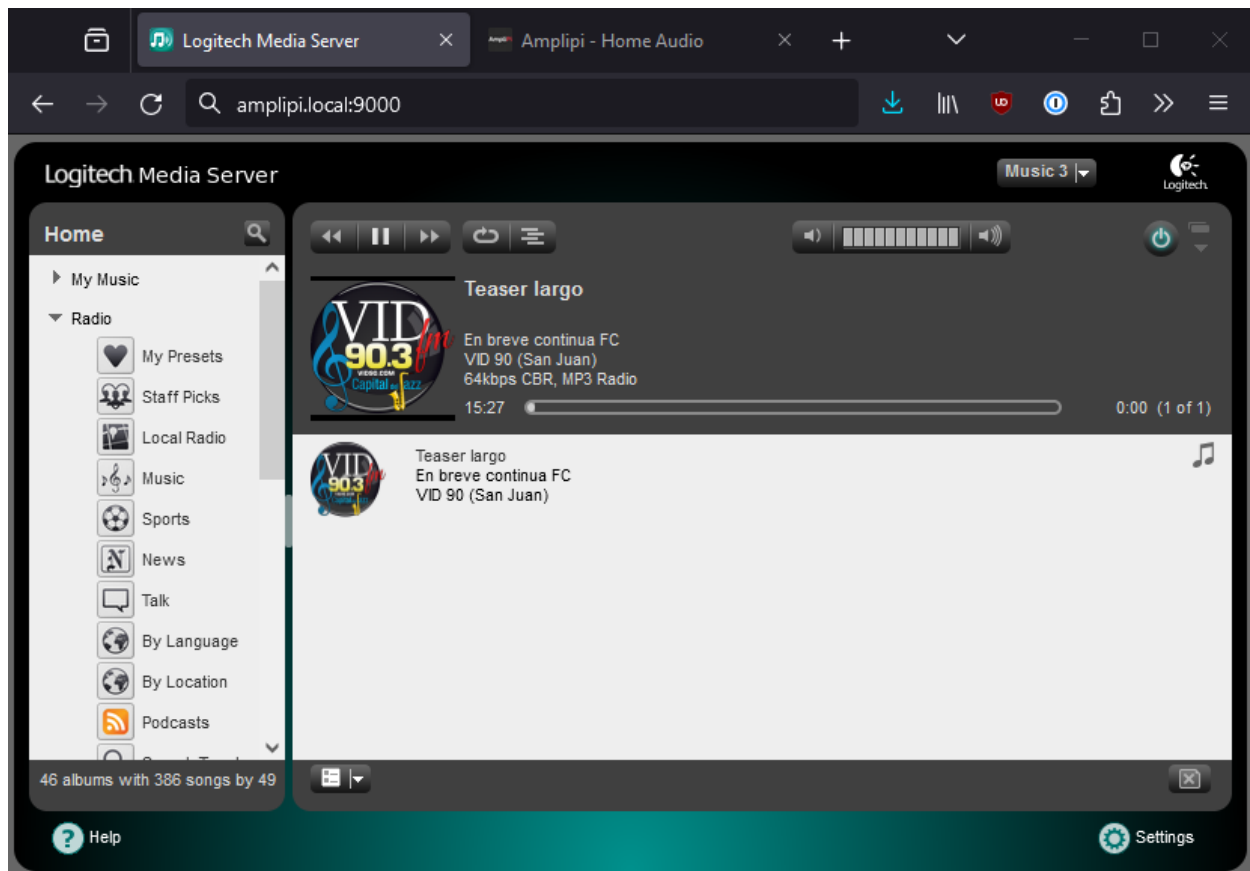


Configuring Spotify on Logitech Media Server (LMS)

Ready to jam with Spotify on all your speakers? Let's get it set up!


1. Open the LMS Web App

- Grab a computer on the same network as your AmpliPro unit.
- Open a web browser and go to **<http://amplipi.local:9000>** (in some odd cases you may need to replace "amplipi" with the actual name shown on your AmpliPro's display).



2. Activate the Spotty Plugin

- Click the **Settings** button in the bottom right corner.
- Choose the **Manage Plugins** tab.
- Find the **Spotty Plugin** and click **Activate**.
- Let LMS restart to finish installing.





3. Connect Your Spotify Account

- Go back to **Settings** and click the **Advanced** tab.
- Use the dropdown box at the top right to select **Spotty Spotify for Squeezebox**.
- **To link your first account:**
 - Either enter your Spotify username and password, or follow the instructions to authorize through the Spotify app.





Spotify Authorization

In order to use your Squeezebox with Spotify, you'll need to authorize Logitech Media Server using one of Spotify's applications. This can be their desktop client, or one of their mobile apps. Please note that authentication is not possible through Spotify's web client. A Spotify Premium subscription is required!

Just follow these simple steps:

1. Start your Spotify client
2. Play some tune in Spotify
3. Open Spotify's list of available devices

4. Pick the "Spotty Authentication" item (music playback might go silence at this point)
5. Wait a few seconds while the application is authorizing Logitech Media Server to use Spotify
6. Don't panic - sometimes it can take a dozen or two seconds 😊

That's it! This screen should disappear.

Sometimes the smart authorization fails. In this case authenticate using your username and password in below form.

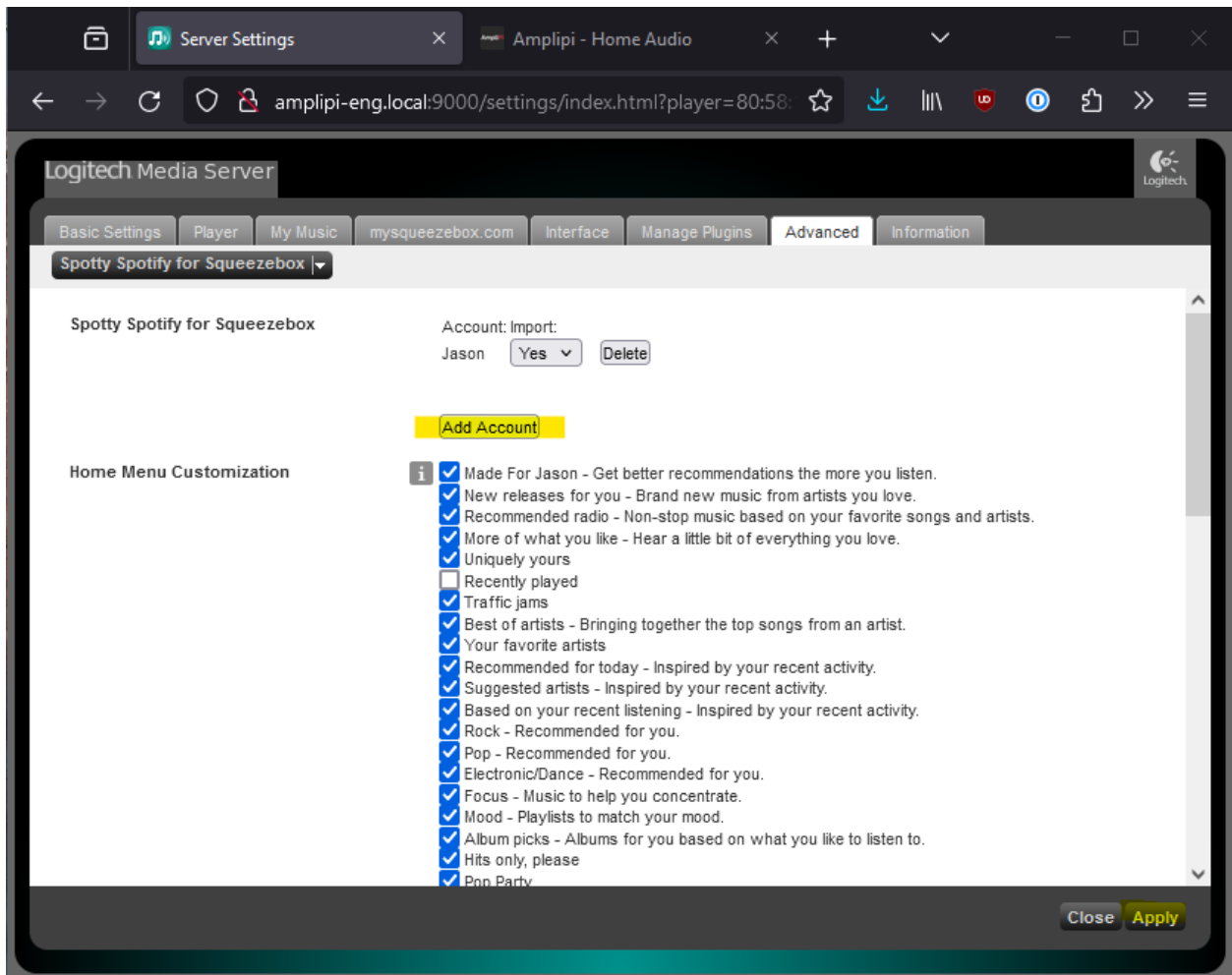

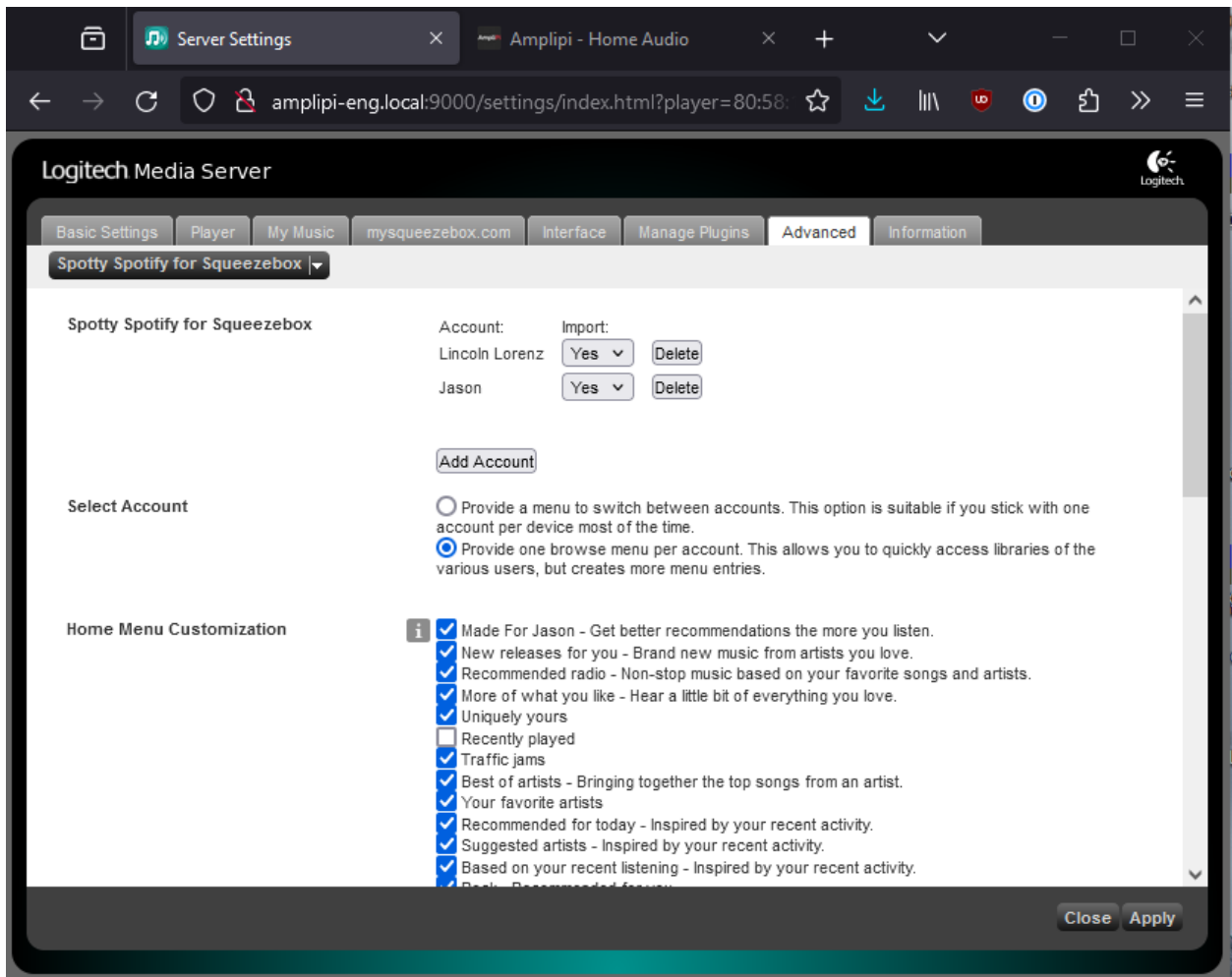

- **To add more accounts:**
 - Click the **Add Account** button and repeat the process.

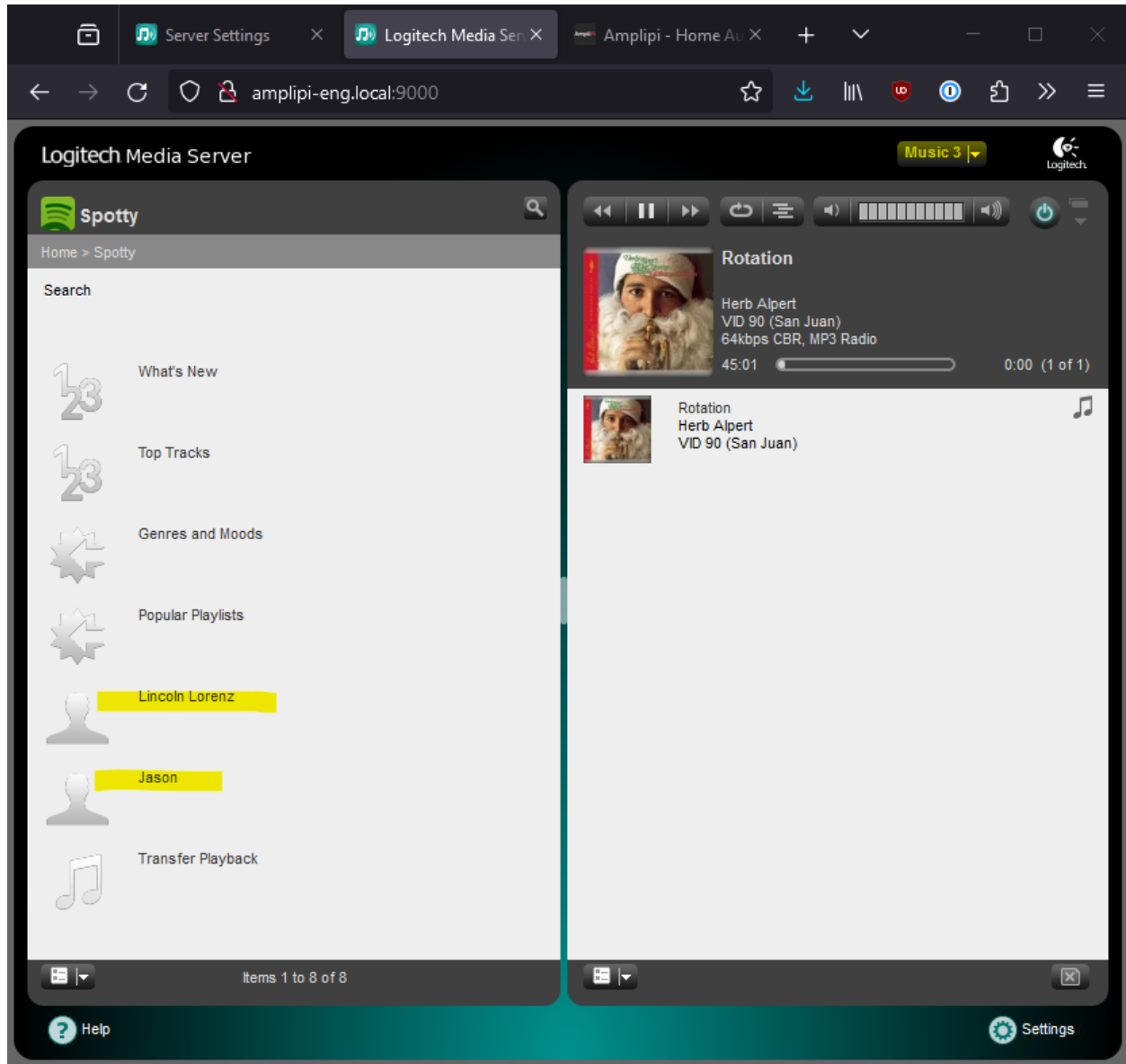


- All currently added Spotify accounts will be shown at the top of the Spotty Spotify configuration. They can be deleted by clicking the delete button next to each account.



4. Test It Out! Using the LMS Web Interface:

- Select one of the players (Music 1, 2, 3, or 4).
- Choose **Spotty** under **My Apps**.
- You'll see links for each added Spotify account – pick one and start listening!

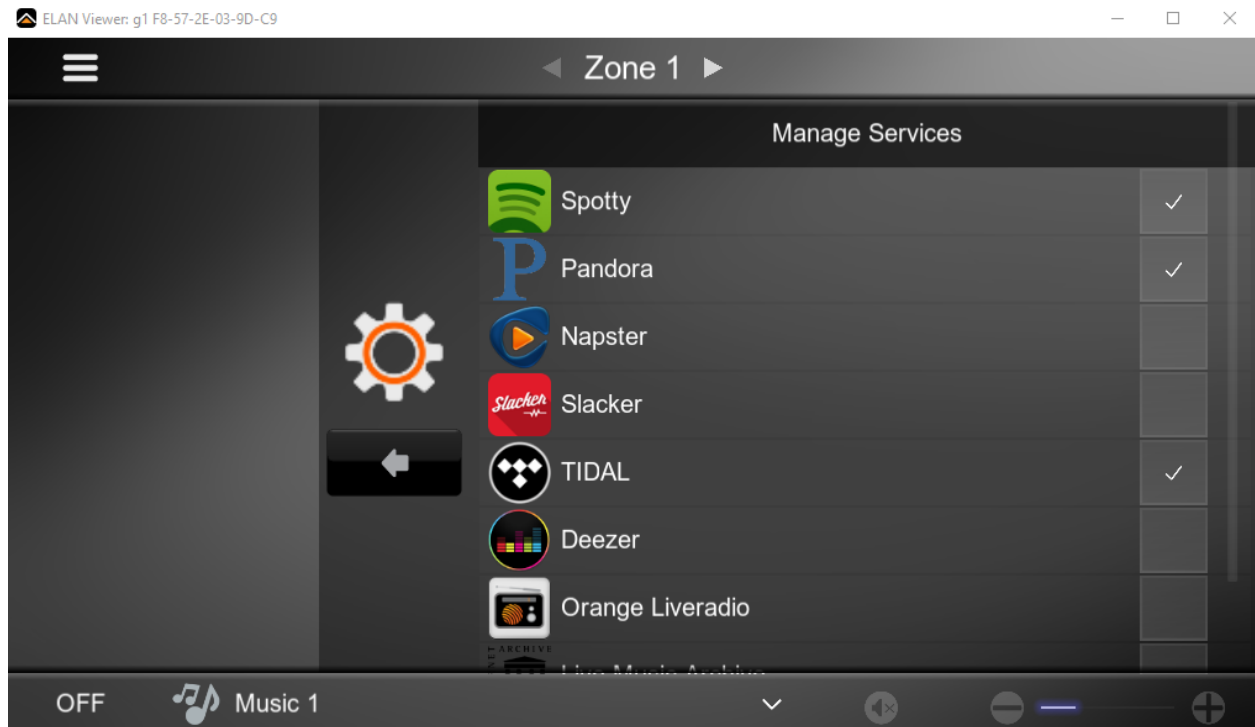


Pro Tip:

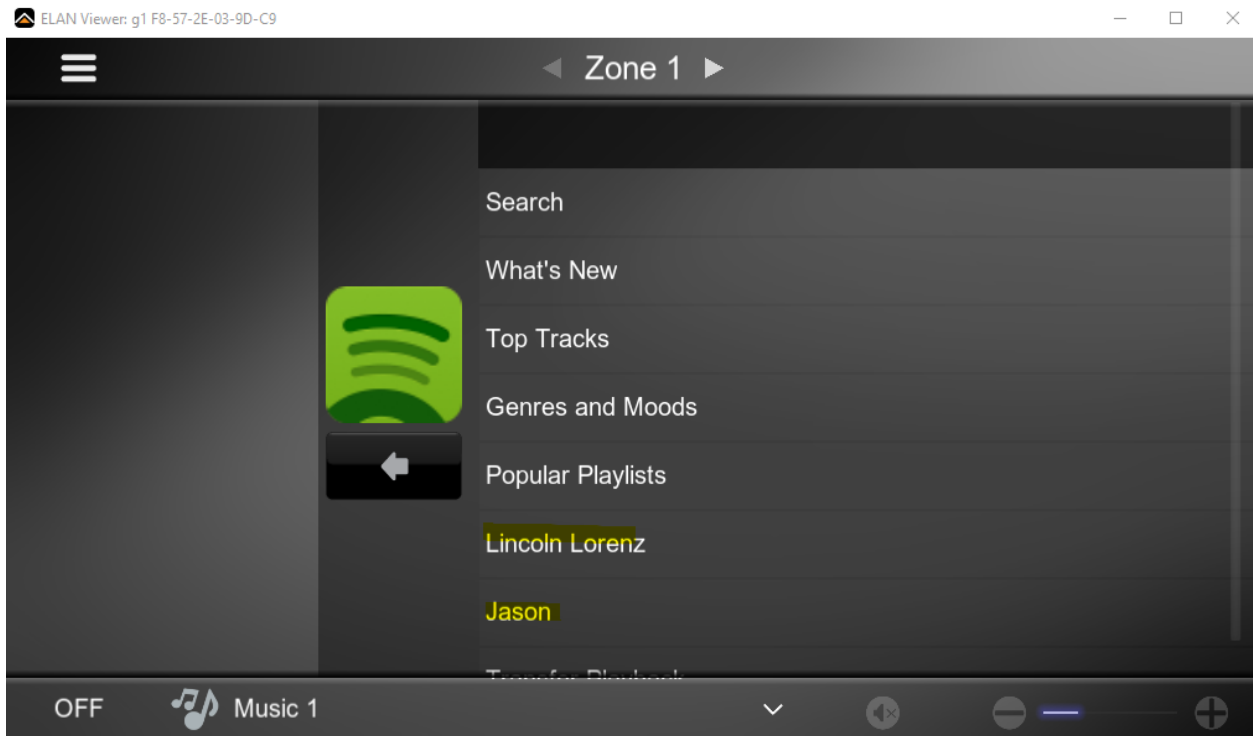
- Each Media player can play music from any linked Spotify account, so you can have different tunes going in different rooms!
- You can stream up to 4 different audio streams at the same time.

Using the Elan Interface:

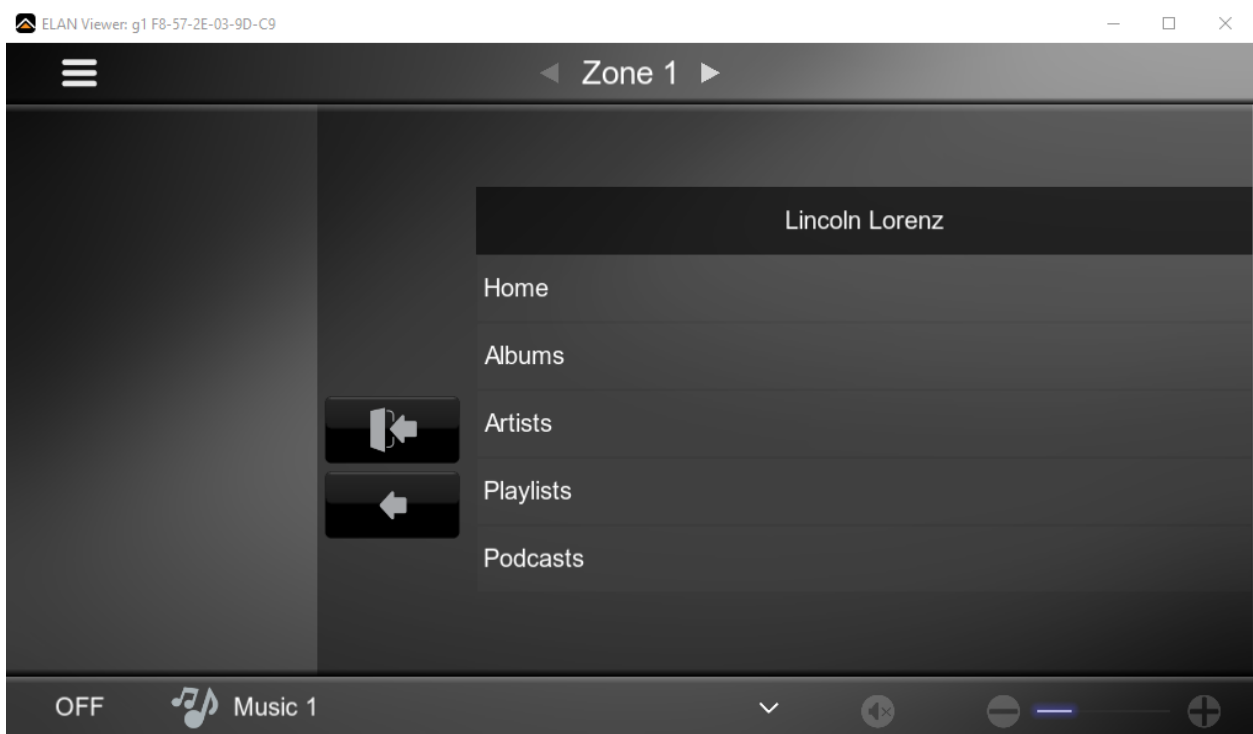
- Assign a zone or group to one of the Media players (Music 1, 2, 3, or 4).
- Click the gear icon and select the **Spotty** service.
- Tap the green **Spotty** icon to browse music from all connected accounts.



- When browsing through music, the top level menu will list all the available Spotify accounts:



- Selecting any account will present choices for streaming Albums, Artists, Playlists, etc:



Elan Pro Tip:
